Goal 1 – IL Network

Support and enhance a well-coordinated Delaware Independent Living Network, for those with disabilities, and their families, in the state, through the provision of the 5 core services with a focus on collaboration and advocacy.

- OBJECTIVE 1: Strengthen the Delaware Independent Living (IL) Network as a centralized hub, fostering collaboration and efficiency among existing resources to empower individuals with disabilities and their families.
- **OBJECTIVE 2:** Increase the number of active partner organizations that serve individuals with disabilities.
- OBJECTIVE 3: Identify key stakeholders.
- OBJECTIVE 4: Explore potential new funding opportunities and resources.

Goal 2 – Community Integration

Foster inclusive communities through the expansion and enhancement of existing infrastructure that promotes accessibility for individuals with disabilities.

- OBJECTIVE 1: Promote community inclusion.
- OBJECTIVE 2: Research and advocate for the improvement of existing transportation options and explore and advocate for alternative transportation options for individuals with disabilities.
- OBJECTIVE 3: Expand existing accessibility programs.
- **OBJECTIVE 4:** Foster collaboration and communication.

Goal 3 - Healthcare

Enhance the capacity of individuals with disabilities to actively participate in their health and well-being.

- **OBJECTIVE 1:** Advocate for increased leadership and ownership for those with disabilities as it relates to their healthcare.
- OBJECTIVE 2: Increase accessibility by advocating and educating about physical, attitudinal, and systemic barriers that hinder access to quality healthcare.
- **OBJECTIVE 3:** Partner with community organizations to increase the availability of home and community-based services.
- OBJECTIVE 4: Advocating for individuals with disabilities to live independently in their chosen communities.

Goal 4 – Emergency Management

Enhance the preparedness and response for individuals with disabilities during emergencies and disasters.

- **OBJECTIVE 1:** Advocate for equitable preparedness.
- **OBJECTIVE 2:** Provide emergency responders with training on best practices for assisting individuals with disabilities during emergencies.
- **OBJECTIVE 3:** Advocate for, and promote existing, accessible communication plans utilizing various formats (e.g., sign language interpretation, Braille, audio recordings) to ensure everyone receives critical information during emergencies.

Goal 5 – Housing

Advocate for people with disabilities to have access to safe, affordable, accessible housing that meets their individual needs and preferences, and fosters independence and integration within their communities.

- **OBJECTIVE 2:** Explore potential new funding opportunities and resources.
- **OBJECTIVE 3:** Advocate for improved, accessible, and inclusive housing options.
